



# Year 1 2025



# In Term Four, the Year One students will:



#### **RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

- Describe some events in Jesus' life where he taught about God's love.
- Explore how Jesus lived as a person of compassion, love and forgiveness.
- Describe some of the events in Scripture that tell something about Jesus' mission.
- Begin to recognise that God wants people, guided by Jesus' life and mission, to live in loving relationship with God, others and creation.



# **READING**

- Identifying different text types (e.g. narratives)
- Learning the features of fiction texts
- Making text-to-self connections (linking stories and facts to their own experiences)
- Developing comprehension skills (identifying characters, settings, feelings, consequences)
- Practising decoding strategies (sounding out and reading unfamiliar words)

## **WRITING**

- The structure of a narrative
- Learn how to use our knowledge from story champs to create narratives
  Use nouns, pronouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs in our writing
- Use capital letters and sentence boundary punctuation appropriately i.e full stops, question marks and exclamation marks
- Accurately use phonemic awareness to spell words

## SPEAKING & LISTENING

- Using new vocabulary in conversations and class discussions
- Practising turn-taking and active listening skills
- Exploring and using language to express opinions
- Sharing ideas about personal experiences or learnt topics

#### **TOPIC: Algebra**

- recognise, continue and create pattern sequences, with numbers, symbols, shapes and objects including Australian coins, formed by skip counting, initially by twos, fives and tens
- recognise, continue and create repeating patterns with numbers, symbols, shapes and objects, identifying the repeating unit and recognising the importance of repetition in solving problems

#### **TOPIC: Length**

- compare directly and indirectly and order objects and events using attributes of length, mass, capacity and duration, communicating reasoning
- measure the length of shapes and objects using informal units, recognising that units need to be uniform and used end-to-end

# **Topic: Volume and Capacity**

- compare directly and indirectly and order objects and events using attributes of length, mass, capacity and duration, communicating reasoning
- measure the length of shapes and objects using informal units, recognising that units need to be uniform and used end-to-end



#### **TOPIC: Ethical Capability**

- ethical concepts including right, wrong, better and worse, and behaviours associated with these
- examples of values, rights and responsibilities, and shared expectations, and reasons they are important

#### **TOPIC: Geography**

- Identify and describe the features of places at a local scale and how they change, recognising that people describe the features of places differently (VCGGC057)
- Describe and explain where places and activities are located (VCGGC058)
- Identify how people are connected to different places (VCGGC059)
