Religious Education

INQUIRY CONCEPT: "His Life. Our Mission"

The students will

- Explore the Kingdom of God and the eternal Mission of Jesus
- Investigate the scripture: Matthew 28:16-20
- Attend a Rosary and year level Mass
- Explore Mary as the perfect disciple and how she is central to the Christian Mission



ENGLISH

In Literacy, the students will

- Explore and practise the strategy of Close Reading
- Learn to write Poetic Prose
- Compare and contrast Narrative writing to Poetic Prose
- Write descriptive passages with a focus on figurative language, particularly personification
- Read different descriptive passages from a variety of authors

In Spelling, the students will

- Continue to work with the SOUNDWAVES program, addressing various graphemes, phonemes and vocabulary.



MATHEMATICS

Algebra

The students will

- explore the use of brackets and order of Operations (BIDMAS) to solve number problems
- recognise and generate different patterns from rules as well as identifying rules in number patterns
- develop their understanding of variables, including substituting numbers for variables in equations

Measurement

The students will

- explore key concepts of length, area, mass, volume and capacity



INTEGRATED TOPIC: Business and Economics

The students will

- understanding resources and focus on exploring natural, human and capital resources
- learning about economic resources and how economic scarcity necessitates economic decision-making
- concepts about taxation, importance of work to individuals and the community and the importance of keeping money safe and spending it wisely

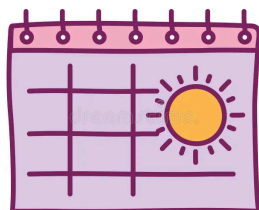
