## TRIUNE GOD

- Making connections with the Assumption of Mary and the Magnificat
- Exploring the meaning of the Nicene Creed
- Understanding of the connections between the Triune God through the Nicene Creed
- Creating an art piece to show our understanding of the Triune God



## READING AND WRITING-GENRE Poetry

- Participating in Book Week activities around the theme "Old World, New World and Other Worlds".
- Exploring shortlisted books and focusing on one each day while participating in various activities to respond to the text.
- Focussing on synonyms, antonyms and word associations to explore word meanings in texts.
- Understanding that text connectives are used to create links between noun groups.
- Using appropriate layouts to separate ideas and incorporate visual concepts and texts.



## GEOMETRIC REASONING

- Using geometric vocabulary to understand concepts, such as acute, obtuse, congruent, angles and perpendicular.
- Identifying and categorising angles.
- Locating angles in our everyday lives.
- Using measuring tools such as a protractor to construct angles.



## INTEGRATED UNIT- EARTH AND SPACE

- Exploring how the Earth is made up of Tectonic plates
- Identifying how Tectonic plate movement causes earthquakes, volcanic activity and tsunamis.
- Understanding the relationship between earthquakes and Tsunamis
